Well, the year is winding down as we head into October. Autumn is in full swing and we've had a bit of Indian summer lately too.

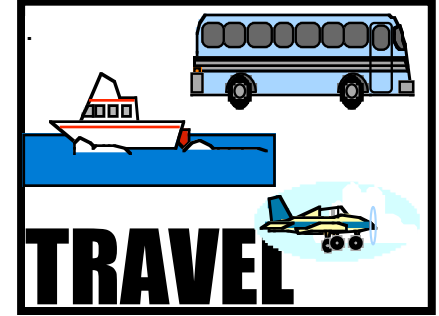
October brings Columbus Day and Halloween. There's also boss's day. Maybe you can pretend you are the boss at home, at least for that one day!

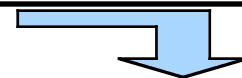

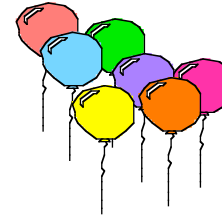

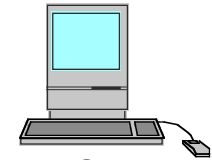
